Born in Glossop Derbyshire, Graham served in the military and retired in the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. He and his wife Susan settled in Old Malden Lane, Cuddington, eleven years ago. During his military service he became the Senior Director of Music for the Household Division, responsible for the music of all major State Occasions. On his retirement, Graham embarked on a second career as a guest conductor and band trainer, mostly in the USA. Graham is also an accredited lecturer of the Arts Society.

During the COVID-19 lockdown, he created an online community programme, CHANNEL KT4, broadcasting on YouTube and Facebook. He has presented over fifty programmes, interviewing local charities, volunteer groups, environmental agencies and religious organisations. Graham says: "The programme is all about highlighting the incredible charitable and volunteer work that takes place on our own doorstep".



Graham supports the Army Benevolent Fund - the Soldiers' Charity - on the London Committee. He organises fundraising events for the Royal British Legion, including the Poppy Dinner. He is the President of the Brentwood Imperial Youth Band and the Southern Highlanders Pipes and Drums.

Graham enjoys walking and discovering new trails in and around the borough. He has recently started playing trombone again after a break of thirty years!

Graham is a keen supporter of Fulham Football Club and looks forward to their immediate return to the Premiership at the end of the season.

Since moving to Cuddington, Graham has become aware of the close sense of community that exists here. He is passionate about the environment - in particular, the welfare of the Hogsmill National Nature Reserve. Graham has served on the Cuddington Residents' Association committee as vice-chair for over eighteen months, is a road representative and also vice-chair of the Standing Committee of Residents' Associations (SCoRA) for nearly a year. He counts the opportunity to represent the people of Cuddington Ward on Epsom and Ewell Borough Council as a privilege; he looks forward to supporting the community that he loves.
